### Grading & Related Procedures

The school year is divided into two semesters of 90 days each. Each semester is further divided into two nine-week (or quarter) grading periods. Classes are 55 minutes long, 6 periods per day, 5 days a week, 18 weeks per semester.

### Class Rank & Honor Points

The grade point average (GPA) is NON-WEIGHTED and is based on a 4.0 scale. The weighted grade point average (WGPA) is WEIGHTED and based on a 6.0 scale. Each Honors class earns one additional honor point and each AP class earns two additional points. Students are ranked each semester by their percentage within the class based upon their WGPA.
